Here's your 'Explore Time! Bingo Board' for this week.

Use this to help you explore at home, like we would in school during our 'Continuous Provision' element of Reception.








**This week;** you only need to choose **at least 1** activity each day because I have added **an extra task to your daily page for Children's Mental Health Week**. You can still complete the learning rainbow (see page 2) over the week (but you'll need to do 2 activities on a couple of days to make this happen - I've kept some short and sweet to help you!) You don't need to complete every activity on this board but you can if you want to.

Just like in school, this is your time to learn through your play and use what you know in a way that works for you. I'd like you to record what you did during your explore time in some way so that you can share it with me e.g. take a photo/video, draw a picture or write something down.

<p><b>Expressive Arts and Design</b></p> <p>Set up a role play shop at home. Can you make some price labels for the items in your shop and maybe some signs? You can make your shop more realistic with some pretend money (or real!) and some customers 😊</p>	<p><b>Physical Development</b></p> <p>Follow the link below to dance along to Baby Shark on GoNoodle: <a href="https://tinyurl.com/yxcqj9yh">https://tinyurl.com/yxcqj9yh</a></p>	<p><b>Literacy</b></p> <p>Login to Active Learn and choose a book to read in the Bug Club area. Click on any bugs you see in your book to answer the questions.</p>	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>Login to your Active Learn account and choose a game to play in the Abacus area. <i>Top tip: use small objects to help you count if you need to.</i></p>	<p><b>Expressive Arts and Design</b></p> <p>Login to MiniMash and click on the orange logo 'WB 1<sup>st</sup> Feb'. Choose the 'Feelings Painting' tab and draw me a picture to show me how you are feeling today. Make sure you save it to your tray so I can see your work 😊</p>
<p><b>Communication and Language</b></p> <p>Grown-ups: set up a treasure/scavenger hunt for your child to follow at home – (this can be as simple or extravagant as you like!). The idea is for the child to practise listening to and understanding simple instructions and clues. Add two-part instructions for more challenge.</p>	<p><b>Literacy</b></p> <p>Snuggle up with a grown-up and listen to them read you a story. Focus on the character's feelings throughout; stopping to discuss how you think the character might be feeling and why. Have you ever felt like this? Can you remember why? Do the characters feelings change in the story? Why do you think that is?</p>	<p><b>Understanding the World</b></p> <p>Collect some natural resources from an outside space i.e. on a walk/in your garden. Use what you've found to make a picture. Here's a good example:</p> 	<p><b>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</b></p> <p>Set up a challenge that you know will be really hard for your child e.g. blindfolded; separate sequins and beads with a spoon. After a couple of minutes, stop and talk about how this feels e.g. annoying, hard, frustrating etc. Use this to talk about how it can feel like this when something is hard but this is actually how we learn! Reflect on how there used to be things they couldn't do but now they can e.g. riding their bike. We just have to spend some time practising and finding ways to deal with the challenges. Discuss ideas: how could we make this challenge easier? E.g. taking off the blindfold, using our fingers instead of a spoon or working together.</p>	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>Login to MiniMash and click on the orange logo 'WB 1<sup>st</sup> Feb'. Choose 'Find the longest' to play a game about comparing length.</p>
