



## Explore Time! Bingo Board WB 08.02.21

Here's your 'Explore Time! Bingo Board' for this week. Use this to help you explore at home, like we would in school during our 'Continuous Provision' element of Reception.

Please choose at least 2 activities each day and see if you can complete the learning rainbow (see page 2) over the week. You don't need to complete every activity on this board but you can if you want to. Just like in school, this is your time to learn through your play and use what you know in a way that works for you. I'd like you to record what you did during your explore time in some way so that you can share it with me e.g. take a photo/video, draw a picture or write something down.

We are expecting some snow this week so I've included some snowy fun below; those that require snow are marked with a snowflake (you never know in England!)

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Expressive Arts and Design Paint/draw a snowy picture.	Physical Development Make some snowballs and throw them at a target.	Personal, Social and Emotional  Development  Complete the 'My Snow Day' sheet with adult support to share how you felt about any snow you might have seen this week.	Physical Development Build a snowman.	Literacy Make a cosy fort and snuggle up to share a book including a snowy scene/theme.
Communication and Language Follow instructions to make a hot chocolate. Remember to ask a grown-up to help you because hot drinks can be dangerous!	Understanding the World Use the internet or some books to find out some facts about Chinese New Year (12/02/21). Use Google Earth/a globe/map to find out where China is.	Maths Enjoy some rice play in a bowl/big tub/tray. Explore pouring, mixing, shaking, sieving etc. with dry rice, funnels, spoons and containers of different sizes.	Expressive Arts and Design Role play running your own Chinese restaurant or take away service.	Maths Play with some coins and sort them into different labelled envelopes.
Understanding the World Experiment with some dry noodles and water. What changes do you notice? Why do you think this happens?	Physical Development Find out how long The Great Wall of China is. Build your own Great Wall using resources you have at home and measure it, how long is yours?	Personal, Social and Emotional Development Share the Aesop's Fable 'The Hare and the Tortoise' (link on webpage) and use the story to discuss the theme 'not giving up'. What have you not given up on and are really proud of? E.g. I learnt to ride my bike.	Communication and Language Share the story of 'The Great Race' (link on webpage). Find out what year you were born in e.g. the year of the monkey. What about your family members?	Literacy Watch Miss Laurence read the story 'Dragons in the City'. In the story, the children write a wish and hang them on the wishing tree. What would you wish for? Can you write your wish down? E.g. 'I wish for…'
