- 1 - A postcard written from your favourite book character to another book character, telling them of an adventure they have had. You could create a picture on the front of the adventure;
- OR
- 2 - Read a book about a sport you enjoy and then create an A3 information sheet of facts about that sport. For example, if you choose football you could find out who holds the record for most goals scored, which team has won the most cups or which player has played the most times for their country.
