Jazz Hands Club – Children will require a pair of trainers and loose clothing they can move in. (PE kit should be fine for this if it is in school.)

Art and Craft Y1+2 – Children who were offered a place last term will automatically be included when the club begins. You will be notified of the starting date separately.

Design and Technology Club – This club will be charged at £1 a session to cover the cost of resources.

Puzzles and Board Games Club – There will be a small charge of £1 per session to cover staffing costs.

Cooking Club – Children will need an airtight/watertight container with a fitted lid for bringing their creations home. This club will be charged at £3 per session to cover ingredients and staff costs.

Football / Cricket Club – For football, players will need football socks and shin pads. Football boots are recommended. Please note football will be running until the 26th May, then we will switch to Cricket and this will continue until the 7th July.

Clubs which require payment should be made following confirmation of a place.

Clubs will not be allocated first come first served to allow everyone equal opportunity, but names will be drawn randomly once all the slips have been returned. If a club is being repeated next term, priority may be given to children who have not already had a space. We cannot guarantee every child a space in any of the clubs so they will be put on a waiting list if the club is already full.

If you would like your child to attend any of these clubs, please complete the form below and put it in the post box outside the school office by **Monday 28th March**. A return slip will be sent home confirming your child/ren's club place the first week of the summer term.

Clubs will run from **Monday 25th April** (Excluding School Holidays/Non-Pupil Days) until **Friday 8th July** unless you are otherwise informed.

If your child has attended Jazz Hands, KS2 Book Club or Mrs Ash's art club, but now no longer requires a place, please let us know.

Finally, if for any reason your child will not be attending an after-school club for which they have registered, the school office must be informed. If your child misses 3 or more sessions in a row, we will offer their space to another child on the waiting list.
