## Swimming Lessons Autumn 2021 - Year 1, Year 2, Year 3 & Year 6

Swimming lessons with 'Get in the Swim' for the autumn term will be from Monday 13<sup>th</sup> September 2021 to Monday 6<sup>th</sup> December 2021 (excluding half term holiday and non-pupil days). Each year group will be allocated a day and time in the morning to swim each week – please see table below:

Year 4 & Year 5 – No swimming lesson on Monday  $4^{th}$  October (Flu Vaccinations in School) Reception Class – will start swimming lessons in spring term. This is to allow them time to settle in school.

The total cost for swimming lessons in the autumn term will be £44.60, the cost will remain the same as this year at £4 per lesson and an administration fee of £0.60. This is to be paid between Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> September to Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> September 2021 through our online payment system Pay360 Education Payments (previously known as SIMS Pay).

If you have not paid by this date your child(ren) will not be permitted to take part in the lessons.

Please ensure that on your child's allocated day they bring swimming costume/trunks, swimming hat and a towel.

The girls swimming costume should be a one piece costume and the boys trunks must be above the knee and preferably similar to cycle shorts. Children are welcome to wear goggles which are of a good fit – the lenses part must NOT sit on the soft part of the eyes and should stick on the face without the strap on the head, this will show that these are suitable for the child. Poorly fitting goggles can lead to permanent eye damage.
