Dear Parents/Carers of Year 5 Pupils

The Eveleigh LINK Academy Trust is planning a trip to Belgium later this academic year. We have booked Friday 5th June 2020 and we anticipate that we will be leaving at approximately 7am and be returning around 11.30pm. The trip is open to all six schools within the trust and we will be travelling by coach via Euro Tunnel. Staff from each school will accompany the children from their own school, but we will be travelling together. We are hoping to take as many children who want to attend the trip. The cost will be approximately £90 but this figure may change slightly depending on numbers. Each school will be travelling under a collective passport if the number of pupils is above 10 or if not, then each child will need their own passport.

During the day, we will be visiting several cemeteries, including Tyne Cott Memorial outside Passchendaele, as well as Hill 62 where we will visit Sanctuary Wood Museum and walk through several preserved trenches. Later in the day we will be visiting the historic town of Ypres and taking part in the last post ceremony at the Menin Gate.

At this stage we are asking parents/carers for an expression of interest to gauge numbers and confirm coaches and our crossing on the Euro Tunnel. Therefore please complete the attached form and return to the post box outside your school office by **Friday 4th October 2019**. We are looking forward to experiencing this important part of our recent history and commemorating events that took place in the past.
