## Year 6 Chessington Trip – Monday 28<sup>th</sup> June 2021

Please be aware of the following information regarding the Year 6 Chessington World of Adventures trip on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> June.

We are leaving school **at 8.30am so children should arrive at 8.15am.** We aim to return to school for 6.45pm depending on the traffic. If we get delayed coming back to school we will notify you by email.

Children are not required to wear school uniform, but must dress appropriately for a day out with school, which involves lots of walking. Sensible shoes or trainers and a raincoat are essential but children must not wear clothing with inappropriate wording, have exposed midriffs or wear short shorts. It will be a wonderful opportunity for them to wear their Leavers Hoodies which will be handed out to the class by the end of this week. The forecast for Monday is variable so as well as bringing a raincoat please ensure they have sun cream applied before they arrive at school and they bring a hat.

Children are able to take a small amount of spending money, for which they are entirely responsible. We recommend no more than £5, which should buy them an ice-cream if the weather is hot.

A packed lunch will be required – no chocolate, fizzy drinks or glass bottles. Please can they bring a water bottle which can be refilled throughout the day at water points around the park.

Electronic gadgets, phones and tablets must be left at home. If your child wishes to bring a camera they may, but they will be entirely responsible for it.

If your child requires travel sickness medication please can this be taken, according to the instructions on the packet before they come into school. If they require a tablet for the return journey, this must be in a bag/envelope, clearly marked with their name and 'idiot proof' instructions as to dosage and timings.
