Subject	Activity	What you will need
Phonics	Today we are going to revise what we know from Phase 2 and further assess what we have learnt. To help you with this I have made a short video called 'YR Phonics Lesson Support 25.1'. Start this now and then press pause when you are ready to complete each section below: 1. Play 'Cake Bake' on Phonics Play 2. Look at the 'Phase 2 Reading House' homework sheet you completed on Friday and make some flashcards for any letter sounds that you need to practise. You can then refer back to these over the coming days/weeks (skip if appropriate) 3. Read the words on homework sheet 'Phase 2 Superhero Words — Reading', and ask a grown up to tick off the ones you can read independently. 'Sound reading' or 'sight reading' are both appropriate and each gain a tick © If your child 'sounds out', but does not yet blend, do not tick these words but still offer encouragement and practise them together Challenge alert! Read the Phase 2 sentences and draw a picture to match. Maths	This week we are going to practise finding the total. We will use this vocabulary: adding, total and altogether. To help you today I have made a short video called 'YR Maths Lesson Support 25.1'. Start this now and then press pause when you are ready to complete each section below: 1. Choose a number from the screen and say it to your partner so that they can complete that many star jumps. Now swap over! 2. Revisit more and fewer — comparing pictures 3. Practise finding the total of two groups — combining pictures 4. Choose 2 types of food you have at home and collect it, organising it into two groups e.g. all the bananas together and all the crisps together. How many do you have of each? How many do you have altogether? 5. Revisit the part-whole model, linking it to finding the total Challenge alert!
