







<b>Lunch</b>	Fab work Year 6! Try to help out at lunch time – you know I love these acts of kindness!

From there you can click on...</p> <p><b>I have marked and commented on any work submitted last week so you may wish to check that first.</b></p> <p><b>In today's lesson we are going to:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>review the meaning of a digital footprint and understand how and why people use their information and online presence to create a virtual image of themselves as a user.</li> </ul> <p>You have been developing a clear idea of appropriate online behaviour and how this can protect yourself and others from possible online dangers, bullying and inappropriate behaviour. Now you will begin to understand:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>how what you share online impacts upon yourself and upon others in the long term.</li> </ul> <p><b>Activities</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Open the Applicants database. Look in work-year6-digital footprint database, or open a file and search for it on 2investigate.</li> <li>This is a simulation of applicants to a college funded by the local premier league football team Halliwell FC. The college has used online searches about people who have applied to have a place at the college. They have then filled in the information that they can find to help them assess who should be offered a place.</li> <li>Look at the record structure by clicking the  button.</li> <li>Use the database to answer the questions about the candidates on the Digital Footprints Database sheet. I have put this on today's Year 6 webpage, right under this lesson.</li> <li>Once you have done this, compare your information that you have collected on the Digital Footprints Database sheet with the information the college collected using the completed resource Applicant Data. This is underneath the first sheet that you have already used.</li> </ol> <p>Did you agree with the college?</p>
