Subject	Activity	What you will need
Phonics	Today we are going to practise the letter sounds we already know and learn a new one too. To help you with this I have made a short video called 'YR Phonics Lesson Support 11.1'. Start this now and then press pause when you are ready to complete each section below: 1. Play Musical Statues, shouting out the letter sounds that I point to. Challenge alert! Can you think of a word that begins with that sound? 2. Learn the new letter sound /b/ and words that begin with it 3. Watch 'Geraldine the giraffe learns /b/' and find your own things beginning with /b/ 4. Go to www.phonicsplay.co.uk and play 'Buried Treasure' (more info within the support video)	 An electronic device to watch the videos and play the game on Phonics Play 'YR Phonics Lesson Support 11.1' video (download from class page) 'Geraldine the giraffe learns /b/' video: https://video.link/w/rOrEb
Maths	This week we are going to revisit what we know about numbers to five and extend our learning beyond, to larger numbers. 1. Count to five and back (you might need a number line to help you when counting backwards as this can be more tricky) 2. Write your numbers to five spread out on some paper/card and cut them up so you have individual number cards (be careful here!) — save these resources: you'll need them later! 3. Collect some small objects and match the correct quantity with each number card e.g. four grapes next to the number 4 card. You could combine this with some daily exercise e.g. collecting stones or leaves 4. Today, we are going to focus on the number that is one more than five — do you know what this is? That's right number six! 5. Watch the Numberblocks episode 'Six' and talk to your grown up if you have any questions or comments to share 6. Practise drawing a number 6 and make a number 6 card to go with your set, collecting six things to match it 7. Build a tower of six blocks 8. Draw a picture with six things incorporated e.g. a ladybird with six spots Challenge alert!
