Subject	Activity	What you will need
Phonics	Today we are going to practise the letter sounds we already know and learn a new one too. To help you with this I have made a short video called 'YR Phonics Lesson Support 5.1'. Start this now and then press pause when you are ready to complete each section below: 1. Practise saying the letter sounds that we have already learnt (if you're not sure of the pronunciation of any of these sounds, the video will help you with this): s a t p i n m d g o c k Ck e u For a challenge: you could practise putting these sounds into CVC words e.g. map 2. Learn about today's new sound: / I' as in robot. We say 'rrr' and shake our head like a dog playing tug of war! See the video for my example! Can you think of any words that begin with this sound? 3. Watch the video 'Geraldine the Giraffe learns r' 4. Can you read this word? I'ed	 A computer/tablet/phone to watch the videos 'YR Phonics Lesson Support 5.1' video (download from class page) Geraldine the Giraffe video: https://video.link/w/aOPCb A pencil/pen and paper or an alternative mark marking surface e.g. a sand/glitter tray
Maths	 Can you segment the words from the pictures? E.g. r-u-n This week we are going to be learning about ways to make numbers to 5. Sometimes this is called 'number bonds'. We are going to be using these mathematical words; 'whole' and 'part'. Watch the Numberblocks episode 'The Whole of Me', listening out for those key words; 'whole' and 'part' Using the episode for support, briefly talk with a grown up about these key words and what they mean Use some cubes or building blocks if you have some to demonstrate that whole numbers can be broken down into smaller parts e.g. 3 blocks and 2 blocks makes 5 blocks all together Work together to write some addition sentences to match your building blocks e.g. 3 + 2 = 5 or 5 = 3 + 2 	A computer/tablet/phone to watch the video Numberblocks episode 'The Whole of Me': https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episode/b08dr1l3/numberblocks-series-1-the-whole-of-me Some cubes/building blocks if you have some or some small items that can easily be moved and counted
