| Subject | Activity | What you will need |

| Phonics  | <p>Today we are going to revisit the letter sounds we already know and learn a new one too. To help you with this I have made a short video called 'YR Phonics Lesson Support 13.1'. Start this now and then press pause when you are ready to complete each section below:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. March like a soldier and say all the sounds out loud 2. Learn the new letter /f/ and words that begin with this sound 3. Watch 'Geraldine the giraffe learns /f/' and go on a sound hunt in your home to see what you can find beginning with today's sound 4. Play 'Roll and Read – f' with a partner <p>Challenge alert! Can you put your word in a verbal sentence? E.g. | Maths  | <p>Today we are going to continue extending our learning beyond five, to larger numbers.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. What number did we focus on yesterday? Remind yourself. 2. Count to seven and back (you might need a number line to help you when counting backwards as this can be more tricky) 3. Today, we are going to focus on the number that is one more than seven – do you know what this is? That's right... number eight! 4. Watch the Numberblocks episode 'Eight' and talk to your grown up if you have any questions or comments to share 5. Practise drawing a number 8 and make a number 8 card to go with your set from yesterday, collecting eight things to match it 6. Build a tower of eight: how many mini towers can you make from 8? E.g. 2 lots of 4, 4 lots of 2, a 3 and a 5... 7. What creatures do you know with eight legs/tentacles? <p>Challenge alert!
