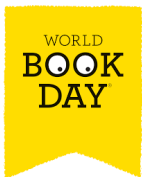


World Book Day: Thursday 5th March

On World Book Day, we will have a special menu in school, inspired by many well-known book characters!



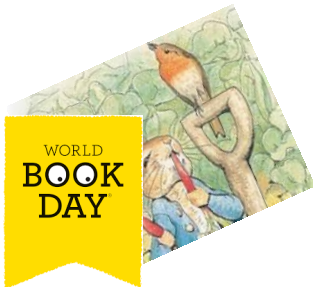
World Book Day Menu
